Following your gastroscopy:

- You may eat and drink as normal
- You may have a sore throat for 24 48 hours
- Report to your GP or A&E if you develop persistent or worsening pain in the neck, chest or abdomen
- Advice can be obtained from the endoscopy unit on – 01493 452370 Monday to Friday 08.00 to 18.00
- In an emergency outside of these hours contact the A&E department on 01493 452559
