

Flexible Cystoscopy Aftercare

- Increase your fluid intake over the next 24 to 48 hours eg an extra four glasses of water a day.
- You may pass some blood in the urine for the first 24 hours.
- You may feel some discomfort/mild burning on passing urine, but this will usually get better after a day or two.
- If you are still experiencing discomfort passing urine, increased frequency, a temperature (above 37.5C, fever or chills) or bleeding after three days, then please consult your GP.
